



California Proposition 65 Act Compliance

ABH® Manufacturing, Inc. is committed to providing safe and compliant products to our customers. We have found that, as defined by the Act, **the exposures from our products is significantly below levels to create no significant risk of cancer or to cause birth defects and other reproductive harm.**

We are continuously working with our suppliers to source responsibly and expect them to meet or exceed regulatory and reporting requirements.

Background

This directive, The California Safe Water and Toxic Enforcement Act (Prop. 65) was enacted in Nov. 1986, and requires the state of California to publish and update [a list of chemicals](https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list) to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity and to prescribe a minimum threshold for those chemicals of concern. The list contains over 800 chemicals and was last updated May 25, 2018 and can be found at <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list> under the Documents section.

Proposition 65 also requires that a business selling products that contain certain identified chemicals in excess of defined levels, provide clear and responsible warning of the potential hazard. For many listed Proposition 65 chemicals, no warning is required on products determined not to exceed “Safe Harbor” levels of exposure. <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/general-info/current-proposition-65-no-significant-risk-levels-nsrls-maximum>
